

# SYRIDE PUTS AIRSPACE ON BOARD.

The manufacturer Syride has just told us that the new SYS'Nav is now available. The SYS'Nav has kept all the functions of the SYS'GPS, but has added even more:

- airspace in Open Air format, allowing pilots to know their position in relation to nearby restricted areas. An indicator warns them about any violation of airspace. Moreover, the SYS'Nav also monitors the height above the ground to alert the pilot to any vertical entry into airspace.
- navigation functions including the creation of an optimal route from an intuitive interface.
- competition compatibility, including the management of exit/entry starts, cylinders, altitudes, IGC files...
- a screen map allowing the pilot to see their position compared to the route, airspace and topography. Designed with the same ethos as the other Syride instruments, the manufacturer wanted the SYS'NAV to be intuitive, simple and fully functional.

## TECHNICAL DATA:

- weight: 83 g, dimensions: 10 x 6.1 x 1.7 (cm).
- screen: 128 x 128 pixels greyscale with backlighting, 100 % configurable.
- battery life: 20 hours minimum with 90 hours of tracklog memory.
- refresh rate: 5 Hz, 56 channel GPS...

This new instrument is small and light.
